REMEDIAL COURSE IN ENGLISH:

Taking into account the global significance of English as a “language of opportunities” a ‘Remedial English Course’ is conducted for underprivileged regional medium students by the department of English. The objective of the course is to enable Marathi / Hindi medium students to use English in a fluent and grammatically acceptable way. Students are encouraged to converse in English through stimulator and role-play activities. A marked feature of the course is its vocabulary-enrichment exercises and word-puzzles. We have an English Language Lab established under U.G.C. scheme. The linguaphone technique makes language-learning an enjoyable process. The Lab meets the global demand of acquiring proficiency in English, a window to the larger world. The Lab comprises of 30 sets of equipment in a full air conditioned room. The software has been installed on 30 PC’s and 30 students can use it at a time. We have in all 8 modules with books and CD’s. The College has provided the facility to students of F.Y.B.Com and F.Y.B.A. A batch of 30 students uses the lab once in a week. The lab has proved to be of tremendous importance and help to all the students of B.A. and B.Com in developing and polishing their Communication Skills which in turn goes a long way in building their confidence and developing a good personality. This also hones their leadership qualities and helps them perform better in the various Campus Placement Drives conducted by various companies in the college.

REMEDIAL COURSE IN MATHEMATICS AND STATISTICS:

The college had observed that about 75% of F.Y.B.Com students in our college opted Secretarial Practice in 11th and 12th Standards. Even they are found to be very weak in simple Arithmetic and quantitative analysis. So, teaching Mathematics and Statistics in F.Y.B.Com classes with 120 students becomes a real challenge. Realizing this difficulty of students and teachers Mathematics department of our college started remedial lectures to the needy students. Classes are conducted on Saturdays after the regular lectures.

BRIDGE LECTURES

Bridge lectures are conducted in the subject of Economics and Political Science for the students who have not studied these subjects in Junior College. Bridge lectures are also conducted in the subject of Accountancy for the students who have come from Science and Arts stream.

- Timely revision of syllabi can bring about effective increase in the grades of students.
- Improvement in Teacher-Student ratio can bring about significant improvement in learning skills of the students.


