Minutes of IQAC Meeting 24th April 2021.

1. Confirmation of minutes of the meeting held on 19th December 2020.

The Committee confirmed the minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 19th December 2020 and the action taken report thereafter was approved.

2. To approve expenses towards repairing of solar system on ex-post facto basis.

The IQAC Coordinator explained that the solar system was not working. Shri. Anup Samant of M/s. Saur Engineer and Consultants Pvt. Ltd. inspected the panels. It was observed that the damage was caused due to rodents and pigeons. The ACP sheets were

also broken. The ACP sheets had to be fitted from 4 sides and a glass had to be fixed in door frame. The expenses for the same were Rs. 25000 + 18% GST (for control panel repairing) and Rs. 10000/- (for ACP sheets and glass). Payment of Rs. 29500/- had been made to M/s. Saur Engineer and Consultants Pvt. Ltd. and Rs. 10000/- had been paid to Mr. Baijnath Sharma towards repairing of the same. The repairing work had been completed. The solar panels are operational now.

3. To inform about expenses on Smoke detector on ex-post facto basis.

The IQAC Coordinator informed that an expense of Rs. 402393/- including GST had been incurred on Smoke detector and fire alarm system. Following are the particulars –

It was proposed that fees of Mr. Deepak Shinde should be met from current years' Student Welfare Fund which would be approximately Rs. 50,000/-.

2. To propose for new courses Bachelor of Accounting and Finance (B.A.F.) and M.Sc. (I.T.) to University of Mumbai w.e.f. 2021-2022on ex-post facto basis.

The proposal for new courses Bachelor of Accounting and Finance (B.A.F.) and M.Sc. (I.T.) had been submitted to University of Mumbai for the year 2021-22 on $29^{\rm th}$ September, 2020. The fee of Rs. 55,143/- had been paid towards the same to University of Mumbai. The college is waiting for approval of the same.
