INTRODUCTION

Shailendra Education Society was established on 31st March, 1976 by 100+ common working citizen specially government employees in the extreme western suburb of Mumbai for providing quality education under able guidance of Prof. D. G. Samant. It has been registered under the Society Registration Act 1860 vide No. BOM/122/1976/GB/BSD and also under the Public Trust Act 1950 vide No.F3962 Mumbai.

The Society established Shailendra Education Society's Arts, Commerce and Science College in 1994 with the launch of Commerce faculty. The Arts faculty was started in the year 1996. The college began with the primary objective of providing education to the lower socio-economic strata of the society who are very often the first generation learners.

To increase the employability of the students the college launched self-finance courses from 2004 onwards. Under the self-finance courses BBI, BMS and B.Sc. (IT) courses are offered. It has also started its journey into the Post Graduate Level by starting the M.Com Course in the year 2016-17. The college has proposed to start Bachelor of Accounting and Finance (B.A.F.) course and the M.Sc.IT. Course and have applied for the same and is awaiting approval. It also has proposed to start a satellite center at Kaman, Vasai from the academic year 2021-22. The Local Inquiry Committee has completed its visit for the same. The college has been sanctioned Research Centre in the subjects of Business Economics and Commerce. It also conducts various Add on Courses in the subjects like Tally ERP, Web Designing, Digital Marketing, Data Science, PHP and Python.

It will also expand on its list of Add-On Courses as it helps the students in availing benefit of receiving the latest knowledge enhancing their capabilities and credentials.

2. To establish industry-academic linkage

The college recognizes that in the coming times the linkages between industry and academics would be an essential factor in bringing in innovation. It is with this aim that the college will be expanding its linkages with industry. The college plans to sign and implement various MoU's with Companies and Start Up's for establishing these links with various players from the industry. Industry experts would be invited as Resource Persons for conducting various activities which are in-line with industry valued skills. Feedback would also be collected by these experts on topics like syllabus, activity approach and the college and keep up the improvement cycle.

3. Strengthen Placement Cell

The Placement of students would be of extreme importance in coming times. The college aims to strengthen its Placement Cell. The college wishes to go beyond conducting placement drive and aim for focus on developing the necessary soft skills in the students. Focus will be on conducting activities based on skills like Resume writing, grooming for interview and development of entrepreneurial skills.

4. Upgraded infrastructure

The college accepts the challenge of its limitation of existing infrastructure. Yet it is committed to push for upgrading the infrastructure to be future proof. Timely development of various ICT infrastructure, Classrooms, Office space and laboratories would be undertaken as and when required.

5. Vibrant extra-curricular activities and extension activities

The college understands that various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities are avenues for showcasing the talent of its students and to develop practical skills like team work and confidence building. Hence the college will expand its activity to provide the avenues for students to develop themselves.

6. Collaboration with NGO's

The College will collaborate with various NGO's for conducting its Green Audit and arrange for various initiatives like safe disposal of its E-Waste and try to establish
